Your Impact

Thanks to the PMA and other donors, along with a significant commitment from the University, Western established the Student Relief Fund in response to the unprecedented need for student emergency financial support as a result of COVID-19.

Each application was reviewed individually, and a special committee was established to allocate support to students during the month of April and into early May – with a focus on students who did not qualify for other bursary or government support programs such as the Canada Emergency Response Benefit (CERB).

- **5,460** applicants
- \$2.6 million awarded
- 3,383 students received support
- \$1,000 awarded to students with the most pressing needs related to food, housing and healthcare
- **\$500** awarded to students for living expenses, impact of travel, access to technology, and other unforeseen circumstances
